**1. INSURANCE**

Each country (in the following: National Judo Federation) is responsible for its competitors (the control of non-pregnancy as well as the control of gender are placed under the responsibility of the National Federations) and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials, during the event described in these outlines.

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

**According to the new rules due to the coronavirus pandemic, COVID-19 testing is obligatory and test should be valid for 48 hours before scheduled departure. Please be sure to have a paper copy of your COVID-19 negative individual medical certificate available for inspection at the airport. Please make sure the certificate also has an English version. A negative COVID-19 test is required for passengers flying to or from Kazakhstan in order to check-in for their flight.**

**All team members are responsible for their own safety.**

**All participants have the mutual responsibility to protect one-another.**

COVID-19 protocol can be changed so please check all the official documents and letters from the organizers and follow the latest version.

**The LOC will keep and follow the IJF and IPC official protocol against the pandemic.**

**LOC are not responsible for any cost resulting from positive cases such as changing of flight or the accommodation.**

**All countries will be tested for PCR in the hotel on the day of arrival and also 48 hours before departure.**

**PCR test will be performed immediately upon arrival.**

**Until the results are obtained, all participants must remain in their hotel rooms and food will be served in the rooms.**

### **Throughout your stay**

1. Wash/sanitize your hands regularly, especially if you have had contact with a person or an object. Competitors should wash and disinfect their hands and feet regularly, especially before the warm-up and the contest.
2. No handshake - greet each other with a bow.
3. Wear a mask at all times (change it at least twice a day). Exceptions: masks are not obligatory on the Field of Play tatami, on the warm-up tatami whilst warming up or on the training tatami whilst training. Masks must be worn in dining areas at all times, except when sitting eating.
4. Maintain 1.5 m distance at all times, except for competitors during training, their contests and during warming up with ONE PARTNER.
5. Submit yourselves to contactless temperature measurement by the LOC on arrival at the point of entry in the country, at accommodation premises, throughout the competition venue and at any official venue of the event, to be accepted by all accredited population. Anyone registering a high temperature will be asked to remain outside and their Delegation COVID-19 Manager, the LOC COVID-19 Manager will be contacted. An opportunity to recheck their temperature will be given, if it is still high a final decision will be made by the LOC COVID-19 Manager.
6. Close contact – a close contact (for the purpose of isolation/quarantine) is considered as a person who is/was:
  - Sharing the same hotel room.
  - Had face-to-face contact at a distance of less than two meters for more than 15 minutes (i.e. training or warm-up partner).
  - Seated together in an aircraft or other means of transport without wearing a mask.

### **In case of a positive test result:**

Quarantine period: Minimum 10 days (including 1 negative tests)

Rates (Full Board per person per night):

Single accommodation: 180 USD

**Anyone with a positive test MUST stay in the quarantine provided by the LOC. The cost must be paid by the National Federation.**

If a positive person takes another test during the quarantine period:

**If positive:** Restart quarantine

**If negative:** Quarantine must be finished

### **Insurance**

It is the responsibility of the National Federation to ensure that in addition to their normal insurance they have sufficient insurance in place to cover any COVID-19-related costs. The LOC of the event accept no liability for any claims relating to cancellation of the event due to COVID-19 or medical costs **for any COVID-19 related illness that may affect a National Federation delegation member during the event.**

2. **COMPETITION VENUE**

«JEKPE-JEK» Martial Arts Palace.

All activities will be at «JEKPE-JEK» Martial Arts Palace which provides comfortable accommodation for more than 200 guests.

If this is not respected accreditation cards will not be given.

If rooms need to be cancelled please inform the organizer immediately. Cancellation of rooms cannot be made at check-in. Illness, injuries or visa problems are not valid reasons for the cancellation of rooms. If rooms are cancelled the organizer has the right to charge the participating delegation. Any damage to hotel property resulting from the stay of a national delegation will be charged to the national federation and must be paid in full.

Delegations are kindly requested not tidy clothing (including judogi) or have training sessions in the corridors of the official hotel.

#### 4. **VISA**

The organizer is happy to help any country with obtaining visa for athletes and officials. For nations, who need a visa to enter the organizing country, please send a full list of participants with full names, passport numbers, date of birth, and positions along with scanned copies of all passports before the deadline stipulated.

#### 5. **TRANSPORT**

The organizer will provide free of charge transportation for competing delegations staying in official hotels during the event. For arrivals and departures, a transfer service is available to official hotel from Nur-Sultan International Airport.

#### 6. **INSCRIPTION OF DELEGATES**

Competitors can only be entered in one weight category and only entries from countries will be accepted. Participating athletes must be 15 years in the calendar year or older.

#### 7. **TRAINING**

Training is the responsibility of the organizing federation. Planning and scheduling of training sessions will be organized taking into consideration requests made by delegations daily on a first request made first served basis. If you are interested in booking training, please contact the organizer.

#### 8. **DRAW**

The Draw will be conducted online.

The top four (4) athletes from the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the current World Ranking List.

#### 9. **JUDO GI CONTROL**

Athletes must compete wearing **an IJF approved judogi** supplied by one of the manufacturers. The current list of manufactures can be seen on the IJF web site:

Each competitor is obliged to have sewn on the back of his/her judogi a backnumber bearing his surname and his/her National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The backnumbers must be fixed horizontally and centred on the back of the judogi. They must be placed at a distance of 3cm from the bottom of the collar. The backnumber can only be ordered from

## 10. AWARDING CEREMONY

The competitors wearing their white judogi (no shoes, flip flops or socks) will stand behind the podium according to the following order 2,1,3,3. Competitors having won a medal have to attend the ceremony to receive their medal in person. If a competitor is absent during the awarding ceremony for no valid reason, they will lose the right to have the medal. It is strictly forbidden for competitors on the podium to bring national flags or the similar identification other than the one represented in the regular manner on their equipment. Any demonstration of religious, political, personal or commercial sign is prohibited and so is wearing a cap or any other head cover.

Winners will receive a diploma, medal and monetary reward.
