& the new judo-gi measure

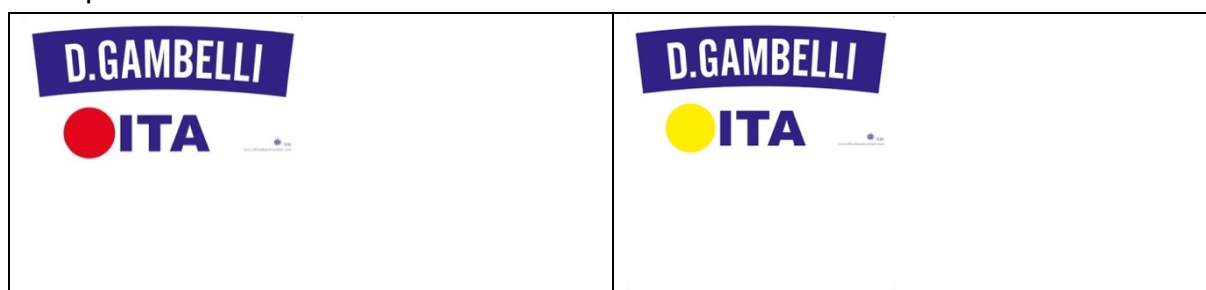


“MARKING ON J1 ATHLETES AND DEAF ATHLETES

J1 competitors are required to wear the red mark. The mark is a red circle placed on the official back number.

A deaf athlete is required to wear the yellow mark. The mark is a yellow circle placed on the official back number. (See the example below.)”

example:



The place of the marking is changed from January 1st 2022.

- The red circle is recommended to use after the first official international eye classification.
 - It is obligatory to use it from the start of the qualification series.
- The yellow circle is recommended to use from January 1st 2022.
 - It is obligatory to use it from the start of the qualification series.
