- The Organizing Committee may make changes based on the number of athletes registered.



- **WEIGHT CATEGORIES (maybe the limits of weight categories can change)**

- Men J 1 (Blind): -60 kg, -73 kg, -90 kg, +90 kg
- Men J 2 (Partially sighted): -60 kg, -73 kg, -90 kg, +90 kg
- Women J 1 (Blind): -48 kg, -57 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg
- Women J 2 (Partially sighted): -48 kg, -57 kg, -70 kg, +70 kg

- **ACCREDITATION**

The control of entries and issuing of accreditation cards will take at the hotel. The accreditation is completed by IBSA, ISAS and by the Judo Classification Master (IBSA website).

At least one team official must attend in time to confirm the entries of all athletes and officials with his/her signature. Athletes' passports (or photocopy) must be available on request.

- **REFEREEING**

The competitions will be refereed by International Referees (IJF A with IBSA Judo license) selected by the IBSA Judo Referees Commission from the highest level of IJF referees.

- **DRAW**

The draw will be broadcast on-line. The link to go live will be communicated at a later time. The best four athletes are seeded by weight categories.

- **WEIGHT-IN AND RANDOM WEIGHT-IN**

The athletes must have their passports and ID cards for the weigh-in; ID card only is allowed for the random weigh-in.



- **JUDO GI CONTROL**

Athletes must compete wearing an IJF approved judogi. The current list of manufactures can be seen on the IJF web site.

Each competitor is obliged to have sewn on the back of his/her judogi a backnumber bearing his surname and his/her National Olympic Committee abbreviation.

The local organisers will inspect the judogi size and validity, the backnumber and publicity that should comply with the current IBSA and IJF.

**It is mandatory to use red circle on the back number for all J1 athletes. In the lack of a red circle, the coach doesn't sit in the coaching box (except of the new J1 athletes).**

- **ANTIDOPING**

- **ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY**

Each athlete must be registered and licensed in the ISAS system before arrival. For classification all athletes should be registered in the database and licensed 6 weeks before classification.

All participating countries must be in good standing with IBSA.

**All athletes must be licensed for 2022 and countries must have paid their membership fee for 2022.**

- **INSCRIPTION CRITERIA**

Participating athletes must be 15 years in the calendar year or older.

Each delegation can inscribe a maximum of two (2) athletes per weight category for the individual competition.



**NB:** Substitution (because of injuries, visa problems or all other reasons) of an athlete will only be allowed up to the deadline of the MDF upload i.e. six weeks before the first classification day. After that date NO substitutes will be allowed to participate.

- **DEADLINES**

Deadline of the entry by numbers: **08th of September**.

Deadline of the entry by names: **23rd of September** - six weeks before the first day of the competition, according to IBSA rules, to be able to arrange eye classification and the appropriate organisation of the competition. Entry forms after the deadline are not acceptable and it would mean that the IBSA Member cannot enter their team in the competition. **During the competition days (08th-10th of November) lunch will be served at the competition venue. There will be no lunch at the hotel during the competition days (08th-10th of November).**

Distance from airport (km) - 25 km

Distance from sport hall (km) – 9.2 km

Hotel reservations must be made through the Organizing Committee. **All delegates inscribed for an IBSA Judo official event must stay in one of the official hotels suggested by the organizers.** If this is not respected accreditation will not be given.

If rooms need to be cancelled, please inform the organizer immediately. Cancellation of rooms cannot be made at check-in. Illness, injuries or visa problems are not valid reasons for the cancellation of rooms. If rooms are cancelled the organizer has the right to charge the participating delegation as follows:

- Up to 30 days before the arrival - full refund.
- From 30-10 days before the arrival - 50% refund.
- From 9 – expected arrival - no refund, 100% of the hotel costs must be paid.

Reservations of extra rooms at the check-in may be surcharged with an additional 10%.

Delegations are kindly requested not to dry clothing (including judogi) or have training sessions in the corridors of the official hotels.

Any damage to hotel property resulting from the stay of a national delegation will be charged to the national federation and must be paid in full.

- **TRANSPORT**

The organizer will provide free of charge transportation for competing delegations staying in official hotels during the Championships and training camp. This includes transport to and from the official hotels, accreditation, the draw, weigh-in, training and competition unless they are within walking distance.

- **CLASSIFICATION (Procedure for the classification of an athlete at a competition)**

- A fully filled MDF, dated and signed by a certified ophthalmologist, must be uploaded in ISAS, **6 weeks before the first classification day of the event**. Only the current MDF (available for downloading from the IBSA website) is accepted.
- The MDF's will be thoroughly checked after they have been uploaded. Athletes without the correct MDF uploaded in due time will not be scheduled for classification and cannot enter the competition. **There will be no exceptions.**
- For athletes with a Review status, tests and complementary medical exams requested in previous competitions should be uploaded at the same time of MDF, 6 weeks before the first classification day of the event. If not, the athlete will be excluded from the competition.
- Each athlete should state in the MDF if they wear optical correction (glasses, contact lenses, filters) when they compete. If so and it was not STATED in the MDF form the athlete will be excluded from the competition.
- All athletes to be classified at an event need to be ready for classification at the first hour on the first day and rested especially if the travel has been long distance. Sleepy/tired people cannot cooperate well and they risk not to be classified. Late arrivals will not be considered for the Classification schedules.
- Only athletes competing in this event can be classified.
- **All countries must use the new Judo MDF for athletes who need to be classified**

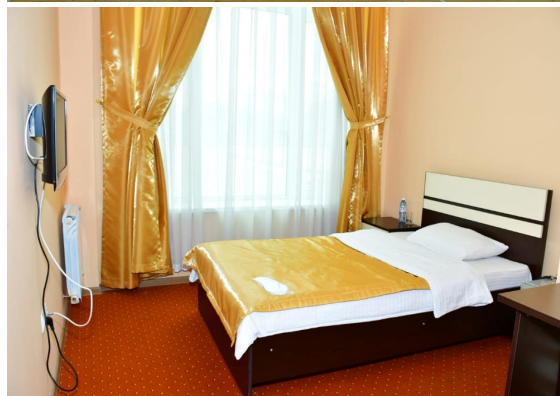


- **Training camp:**

Venue: Sumgayit Olympic Sport Complex

Dates: 11<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> of November.

The price for one person per night including the full board (sauna, fitness, swimming pool) will be 110 USD. Transfer from the official competition hotel to the training camp and after the end of the camp to the airport also will be provided.
