7. VISA

8. COMPETITION RULES

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR, IJF & IBSA judo refereeing Rules, IJF Code of ethics and actual Anti-Doping Rules. System of competition: double repechage or round robin (it depends on the number of participants).

Weight Categories: Individual Competition only

Men: J1 -60kg, -73kg, -90kg, +90kg

J2 -60kg, -73kg, -90kg, +90kg

Women: J1 -48kg, -57kg, -70kg, +70kg

J2 -48kg, -57kg, -70kg, +70kg

Duration of Contest: 4 minutes for both Men and Women (real time)

9. REFEREEING

The contest will be refereed by Continental and/or International Referees. The referees will use **CARE** system.

10. INSCRIPTION OF DELEGATES

Competitors can only be entered in one category and only entries from IBSA member will be accepted. Any change in weight category will not be accepted once entered by name. Participating athletes must be 15 years old in the calendar year or older.

Each national federation including Japan can inscribe **a maximum two (2) athletes per weight category.**

11. ATHELETES' ELIGIBILITY

Please note that all athletes must comply with the following conditions before being accepted to the event.

- IBSA Athlete License for the current year.
- Paid IBSA Membership fees for the current year.
- Participating athletes must be born in 2007(15 years in the calendar year) or before.
- The all judokas must wear **White Judogi (No Blue Judogi allowed to wear).**

12. EYE CLASSIFICATION - Competing athletes only.

A fully filled out MDF, dated and signed by a certified ophthalmologist, must be uploaded in ISAS by 23 October (8 weeks before the first classification day). Only the NEW JUDO MDF (available for downloading from the IBSA website) to be used.

Athletes without the MDF uploaded in due time will not only be able to schedule for the classification, but also cannot enter the competition. There will be no exceptions.

14. ACCREDITATION

The control of entries and issuing accreditation ID will take place at the (to be determined). Team manager will be advised a specific time slot/place so that he/she can confirm the entries of team members and receive accreditation IDs for the team in person.

15. JUDO GI CONTROL

Athletes must compete wearing **an IJF approved Judogi** supplied by one of the following manufacturers. <https://www.ijf.org/supplier-list>

The competing athletes have to wear a judogi with a back number. The judoka who does not wear a back number on her/or his judogi **will be disqualified.**

The local organizers will inspect the judo-gi size and validity during the judo-gi control.

The backnumber and publicity should comply with the current IBSA, IJF rules. All previous advertising has been removed.

16. WEIGH-IN

The official weigh-in is scheduled on 11th, the day before the competition.

Competing athletes must bring their passport and accreditation ID to the official weight-in **location, (TBD)**

17. COACHING

Coaches nominated by their IBSA Members should respect the IBSA Judo Regulation Code of Ethics. Any coaches not adhering these rules could be subject to disciplinary action. Other rules and details: IBSA Judo regulations. (These can be found on the IBSA Judo website)

20. FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES

All-IBSA member federations, coaches and athletes participating in the event described in these outlines have to respect and accept the authority of the IBSA officials, the IBSA Statutes & rules, the IJF Sports an Organization Rules (SOR), the IBSA Refereeing Rules and IJF Code of Ethics. Individuals deemed to have acted against the above-mentioned rules, its principles or purposes shall be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation cards.

All judokas have to possess an IBSA ISAS code and must be registered on the IBSA Sport Administration System (ISAS).

21. INSURANCE

Each IBSA member Federation (in the following: IBSA Member Organizations) is responsible for its competitors (the control of non-pregnancy as well as the control of gender are placed under the responsibility of the National Federations) and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials during the event described in these outlines.

Each IBSA member federation is responsible for ensuring adequate insurance in the case of COVID-19 illness and quarantine, of any member and/or competitor from their delegation during the event. This insurance should cover the conditions of Japan Government for quarantine, testing and if required, medical assistance in case of a COVID-19 positive test.

The organizer of the event and the IBSA will not be responsible for any



insurance related to the above-mentioned matters. Nevertheless, the IBSA Members Organizations staging the event shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration.

The organizer of the event and the IBSA have no liability for any claims of injury, illness or death arising out of the participation and travelling in connection with this event.

The organizer of the event and the IBSA have no liability for any claims of changes to accommodation or travel arrangements due to any COVID-19 related issue. It is responsibility of the attending federations' to ensure their insurance covers all potential circumstances related to COVID-19.

COVID-19 Information

The Japanese government plans to announce measures to relax immigration restrictions in October as a measure to prevent the spread of COVID-19. New immigration regulations will be announced at a later date.
