¹ No of using mats: the number of participating judokas defines the number of mats. In case of 150 and over judokas it is needed to use 3 mats.

7. Grand Prix Alexandria / EGY March 9-16th – one mat
8. Grand Prix / [joint event with IJF Antalya TUR](#) April 3-4 – 3 mats (remark: if the organizer provides only two mats we need 3 day-competition, depending on the number of judokas.)
9. Asian Championships Nur-Sultan KAZ, April 29-30- 2 mats
10. „Small County Challenge” ESP June – July- don't need referees
11. European Para Championships Rotterdam NED Aug 8-9-10 – 2 mats
12. IBSA World Games Birmingham GBR Aug 18-27 – 3 mats
13. Grand Prix / [joint event with IJF Baku AZE](#) 25-26 September - 3 mats
14. Asian Paragames Hangzhou – CHN October 22-28 – 2 mats
15. Parapan Games (joined J1 and J2) Santiago CHI Nov 17 to 25- one mat

17. Grand Prix Heidelberg February 14.-19.- 3 mats
