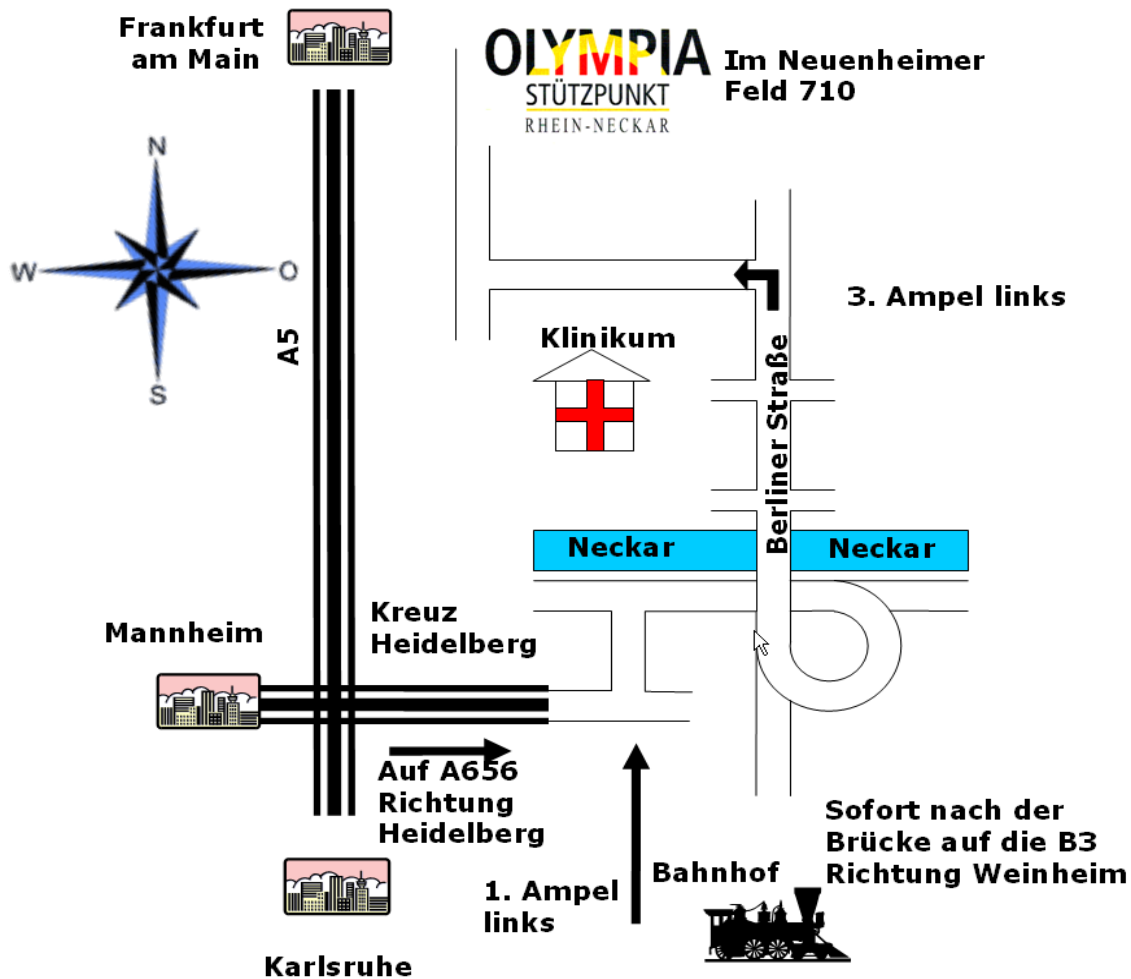

## How to find Olympiastützpunkt Rhein-Neckar:

**By car:** At the end of highway "A 656" follow the sign "Olympiastützpunkt Rhein-Neckar"



### By tram and bus:

1. Take the tram „line 24“ from main station to “Technologiepark”. Then change to bus “line 37 – Olympiastützpunkt Rhein-Neckar”.
2. Take the bus “line 32” from main station to “Jugendherberge”. Then change to bus “line 37 – Olympiastützpunkt Rhein-Neckar”.

**Protection regulations:**

1. With the registration the associations and starting communities ensure the match ability of their athletes.
2. All participants must be in the possession of a valid starting passport.

Participants who do not fulfil these conditions are losing their starting rights.

**Doping:**

**Doping is not permitted according to the anti-doping regulations of the IBSA.** With registration the participants declare the acknowledgement of the anti-doping regulations of the IBSA.

For this reason, all participants must carry a listing of the taken medicines with medical indication, to be able to submit this list if necessary. If this indication proof is missing, the athlete can be punished in the case of a positive result.

Athletes who need substances for medical indications which are listed of the WADA–Prohibited list must exhibit a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

**Liability:**

The DBS and its organs are responsible for accidents only within the borders of the existing liability insurance protection. The liability for accidents going beyond it is expressly excluded.

Requirements from the sport accident insurances of the national sport federations or of the DBS are not affected by this limitation of liability.
